

.22 Rifle Silhouette Match

Cherokee Rod and Gun Club invites all area .22 Rifle Shooters to our Silhouette matches in 2021.

We will have six matches this year, April 13, May 11, June 8, July 13, August 10 and September 14 all 2021.

We will meet on the second Tuesday of the scheduled months with sign up beginning from 8 to 9 AM and the first relay for score will start at 9 AM. A maximum of 8 shooters per relay will scoot the course under command of the range master. Relays will continue until all competitors have completed the course of fire. Matches are normally completed before noon.

Course of fire will be 40 shots, 10 shots at each bank of silhouettes. Chickens at 40 yards, Pigs at 50 yards, Turkeys at 75 yards and Rams at 100 yards. Targets must be struck in left to right order and the silhouette must fall over to be counted as a hit. Silhouettes knocked over out of order will be counted as misses. All shooters will have 2 ½ minutes and 5 shots to shoot at the first 5 silhouettes, after a short break again 2 ½ minutes for the last 5 silhouettes in that bank.

Any .22 Rimfire rifle firing .22 Short, Long or Long Rifle standard velocity ammunition is legal for these matches. **NO HIGH VELOCITY AMMINUTION ALLOWED.** It will break the silhouettes. Any sights are allowed. No slings or shooting coats. Eye and ear protection is required for all shooters and spectators. All shooting is done unsupported and offhand.

Entry fee is \$5.00 per match. Scores will be recorded for recognition of the 2021 aggregate winners. There will be6 matches and 5 highest scores recorded by each shooter will count toward the year to date trophy awards.
